## **Limited Production Well Recognition Instructions**

In order to request recognition from the EAA as a limited production well, please submit: (1) a well registration form; (2) a meter registration form; and (3) a check, money order or online payment receipt for \$25 as your first yearly administrative fee. **If possible, please submit all items together.** 

### 1. Well Registration Form:

A well registration form is attached as Attachment A. If your well is already registered, please fill out the form to amend to your existing well registration.

### 2. <u>Meter Registration Form:</u>

A meter registration form is attached as Attachment B. Because your well is capable of producing more than 1,250 gallons per day, a meter with a non-resettable totalizer and periodic monitoring are required to ensure annual consumption remains below 1.4 acre-feet. If possible, please include a photo of the meter serial number and meter reading.

### 3. Administrative Fee:

A \$25 administrative fee is required to be submitted to the EAA each calendar year. Along with your registrations, please enclose a check or money order payable to the Edwards Aquifer Authority. Please do not submit cash. This fee is intended to cover administrative costs incurred by the EAA (including inspections and data management) associated with limited production wells. For the first year of limited production well recognition, a well owner is required to pay the administrative fee at the time of registration. For subsequent years, the EAA will invoice the well owner no later than **January 15<sup>th</sup>**.

Please note, if you wish to submit these forms via email or fax, the Limited Production Well process is not complete until our office receives the \$25 administrative fee. Please include the payment receipt as an attachment on your email or fax. #### EAA Meter Assistance Program

It is the responsibility of the well owner to meter and maintain the meter on their Edwards Aquifer well. Some well owners who have not metered their wells may not fully understand these requirements, or claim a financial hardship in obtaining and installing the meter. The Board of Directors have agreed to allow EAA staff to assist well owners who may want extra help and ease of payment. Under our assistance program, the EAA offers to obtain for you an approved meter, have an EAA approved contractor install the meter, and allow you up to one year to reimburse the EAA for those direct costs.
